Undocumented Worker Fund – COVID-19 Resources

As of May 21, 2020

Grants of up to \$300 for undocumented workers and families who have been impacted by the coronavirus pandemic.

Eligibility

Any undocumented worker or family excluded from government aid and affected by the pandemic is eligible to apply to the Undocumented Worker Fund, even if they have no affiliations with the sponsoring organization.

Application

The application is open to 2,500 people and will close immediately after receiving the specified amount of requests. **Applications will open on Friday, May 22, 2020 at 7 p.m. EST/4 p.m. PST.**

Basic questions such as the applicant's name, state and city, and how the applicant has been affected by the pandemic will be required on the application form. Phase two of the application process involves a call from the sponsoring organization regarding additional information such as payment details.
